Radio Frequency Analysis at Fiber-Based Cell Sites

Interference artifacts in cellular networks are becoming more prevalent with the increasing number of active transmitters on the RF spectrum. In addition, interference can also be generated within the cell site as a result of improper conductivity generating intermodulation products that can interfere with the transmitting signals of mobile devices.

The ability to detect interference is a challenging and expensive task on distributed cell sites since RF access was removed from the core of the radio to the RRHs which are installed next to the transmitting antennas.
